## BRIEF ABOUT NEAID

North East centre for Equity Action on Integrated Development (NEAID) is a not-for-profit, apolitical, indigenous philanthropic organization led by people of the region to support sustainable development through integrated approaches. NEAID is working primarily in tribal and rural areas focusing on Quality Education, Health, Water & Sanitation, and Disaster Relief. The intervention areas of NEAID aims to achieve sustainable development goals (SDGs) 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6 in Northeast India. NEAID programs are designed in such a way that it complements the existing public system and empowers the stakeholders for larger impact and sustainability. NEAID believes that education, good health, and gender empowerment are interconnected and can bring a family out of poverty and uncertainty. In the past during Disaster response, NEAID had worked in the states of Assam, Mizoram and Manipur in partnership with Government departments to impact the lives of more than 34000 lives so far.

# BACKGROUND

## The Extent of Destruction

NEAID initiated the Disaster relief project for the year 2022 after the flood situation in Assam took a critical turn in the month of July'22. According to officials, 32 districts have been inundated with flood and 6 districts have witnessed landslides, affecting 2.2 million people over the span of 2 months.

The flood has expanded over 96 Revenue Circles and 2,930 villages, more than 130 people have lost their lives due to the torrential downpour, and nearly 2.7 lakh people were displaced from their houses who have taken shelter in 499 relief camps, while another 519 relief distribution centers are also operational.

Other than shelter, the flood victims (Around 900 families) in different locations also lack supply of drinking water and dry rations, healthcare etc. The destruction is not limited to humans alone. Over 60,000 animals have been washed away during the floods. It has endangered the animals in 55 wildlife camps and has claimed the lives of many.

## **AN OVERVIEW: What causes floods in Assam?**

Around 40 percent of Assam's total land area is flood-prone, that is 31.05 lakh hectares against the total area of the state of 78.523 lakh hectares. Assam alone constitutes nearly 10 percent of the total flood-prone area in the country.

The average area affected by floods annually is 9.31 lakh hectares and the annual loss due to the floods in Assam is estimated to be around Rs 200 crore as per the data by Assam's Water Resources Department. The devastation this year is already apparent. Here is what makes Assam extremely vulnerable to floods.

There are the two main rivers in Assam, The Brahmaputra and the Barak, which have over 50 tributaries feeding them, these spread across the state. They are generally the reason for floods in Assam year after year, these overflow in times of high precipitation and cause floods.

The floods have got worse over the decades, this is evident due to the increase in width of the Brahmaputra with time. The width has increased up to 15 kilometers at some places due to soil erosion. More than 4.27 lakh hectares (7.4 percent) of land have been eroded away by the river and its tributaries since 1952. According to a report by the state's Water Resources Department, Assam loses nearly 8000 hectares of land to erosion by the river each year. As a result many households end up from above poverty level to below poverty level due to loss of land and property.



## OBJECTIVE OF THE RELIEF PROGRAM

During Assam floods, NEAID interventions are planned based on the need assessment done by its volunteers or based on the request received from the district administration. The activities are planned and implemented to support the people affected by the floods with the basic necessities for survival during this difficult period. NEAID had worked at grass-root level in partnership with communities and local organizations to understand the ground realities and set up plans for quick response.

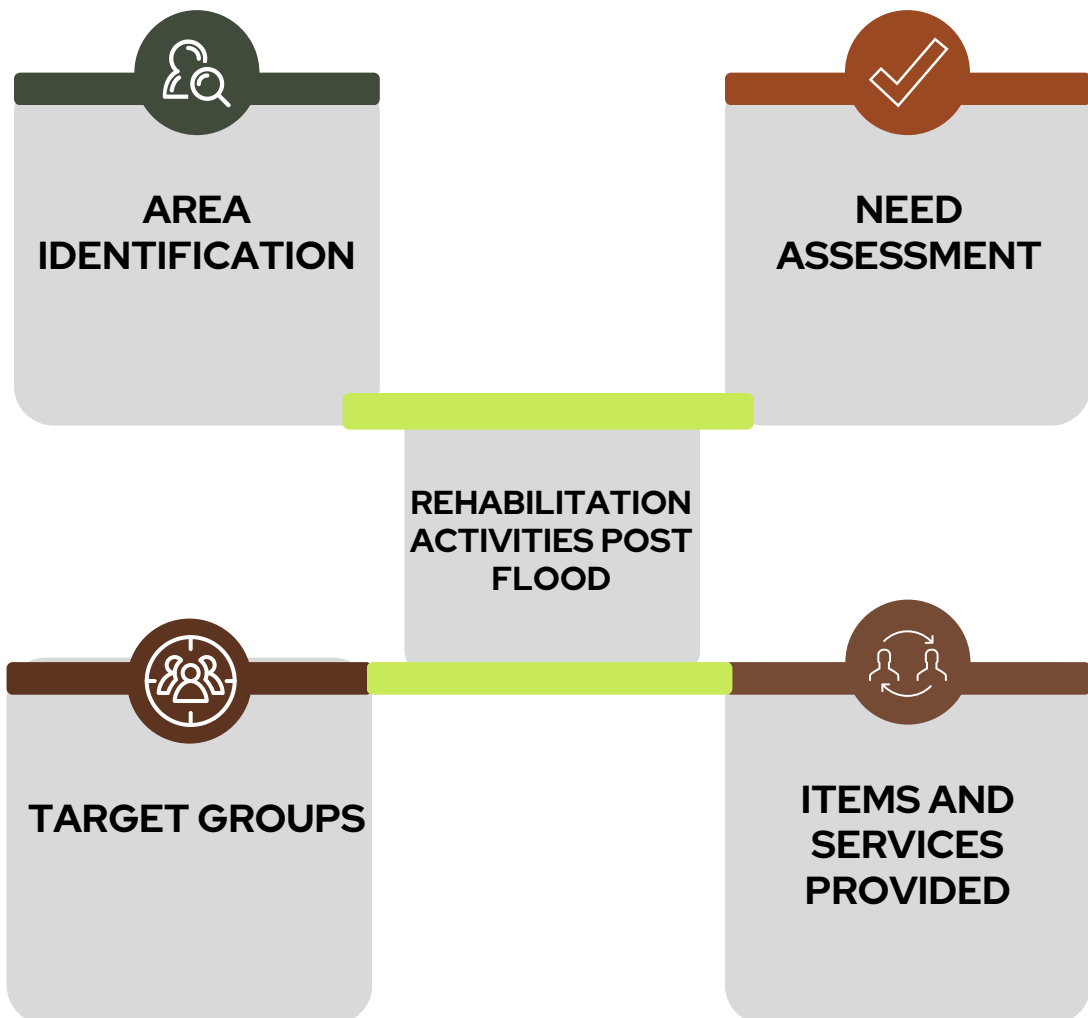
The main objective of the Relief activities are:

- to reach out to as many households as possible with relief items. and support households to take care of each member of the family.
- to ensure health and well-being of Mother, Children and Elderly.
- to ensure that people affected by flood can stay in relief camps with dignity and re-start their previously ongoing activities and lifestyle.





# RELIEF METHODOLOGY





## Area Identification

Different areas in eight flood affected districts were identified for relief & rehabilitation activities based on the extent of the destruction in the region, NEAID's capacity to respond quickly and request received from the district administration. The intervention districts are Morigaon, Nagaon, Lakhimpur, Dhemaji, Kamrup, Darrang, Dima-Haso, Bongaigaon and Nalbari. Multiple blocks/villages were covered in these districts through our relief program in coordination with district administration, local partners and field team from different programs who are based in this districts.







## Need Assessment

NEAID team members from other program such as Education, WASH and Health who spread across these districts are engaged to interact directly with the people affected by the floods. This is to find the total headcount of each village/block who have suffered losses and also identify the types of requirements of these people. This helps in formulating a village-specific requirement to cater to the various needs of the people.

This had helped to identify the number of villages which need health camps, dry ration, Wash kit, rehabilitation, provision for clean drinking water, and other relief materials. Many of times, we have received request for district administration to provide few items in a particular area as per their list.





## Target Group

NEAID's disaster response focuses on the well-being of women and children, and people are staying in relief camps and temporary shelter. Hence we are deliberately working towards building the community and services which directly impact women and children. We have prepared relief kits targeting beneficiaries of the categories such as; pregnant women, labor women with children aging from 0 - 6 months, and young children aging from 6 months to 2 years.

Aside from this, we also reached out to approximately 6000+ households of farmers, and people below the poverty line inclusive of everyone who was affected in the regions.





## Items & Services Provided.

Items distributed are in collaboration with the District Disaster Management Authority [DDMA], Health, Public Health Engineering, Social Welfare, Education and Veterinary Departments.

### 1. Dry Ration Kits:

Dry ration kits were provided to households who are affected by flood. The kit contains food items which are sufficient to feed a four-member family for a week with two meals a day. NEAID distributed 4000+ dry ration kits in various locations in Nalbari, Kamrup, Darrang, Bongaigaon, Lakhimpur, Dhemaji, Morigaon, and Barpeta.

### 2. Special Relief Kits for Mothers and Child, Pregnant Women:

Special kits including food supplements for children, lactating mothers, and pregnant women, sanitary pads, baby food, Over-the-counter ointments, baby cloth sheets, etc were provided to 5557 beneficiaries in different categories in the districts of Morigaon, Kamrup, Dhemaji, Bongaigaon and Lakhimpur.

- Pregnant Women Kit
- Mother and Child Kit/ Infants Kit (aging 0 - 6 months)
- Young Child Kit (aging 6 months - 2 years)

### 3. Provision of Sanitary Napkins and Chlorine tablets:

Sanitary napkins and chlorine tablets were distributed via ASHA and AWW with clear instructions on the utilization of the products. Awareness and demonstration sessions were conducted by our field team members during the distribution process in each village about the importance of the usage of both sanitary pads and chlorine tabs to ensure good health. The items were provided in the districts of Morigaon, Kamrup, Dhemaji, Lakhimpur and Nagaon.



## Items & Services Provided.

### 4. Medical camps in flood-affected areas:

Medical camps were set up in partnership with Health Department in flood-affected areas in Morigaon and Barpeta District. NEAID facilitated the mobilization of beneficiaries, identification of sites, refreshment to the medical teams, and supply of required medicines, such as fungal ointments, gentian violet, lotions, etc. The camps were set up during and post-flood as per the requirements and prevalence of diseases in a particular area.

### 5. Installing Breastfeeding cum changing corners in relief camps:

The NEAID team had installed Breastfeeding cum changing corners in relief camps for lactating mothers and female occupants. There is a demand for the same in 15 relief camps in Nagaon, Morigaon, Nalbari, and Kamrup Rural. 7 Nos. of Breastfeeding corner cum changing rooms were installed in relief camps.

### 6. Building make-shift shelters:

Tarpaulin and plastic sheets were provided to the families who have taken shelter along the roadsides by building small huts, and to households who need temporary arrangements to repair the roof of their kutchra house. 352 Nos. of beneficiaries had received the items in Dima Hasao, Dhemaji, Morigaon, Kamrup, and Darrang.

# REHABILITATION AND POST FLOOD ACTIVITIES

NEAID has undertaken various activities to support the families to restart their previously ongoing activities and lifestyle. Few activities are ongoing since the inception of the Assam flood and other activities are conducted post-floods.

## New activities:

- 1. Building Bamboo bridge:** Due to the flood, the connectivity of small villages with the nearby town, schools, and hospitals got disrupted as flood water washed away the existing bridge. To ensure that people can have access to nearby health facilities and students can commute to schools, NEAID had constructed temporary Bamboo Bridges connecting 6 villages and 2 districts.
- 2. Medical camps in flood-affected areas:** Medical camps are on-going activities carried out in partnership with Health Department in flood-affected areas in Morigaon and Barpeta District. However, post-flood the emphasis was more on screening and identification of children who are borderline from normal to mild or moderately malnourished. Special Kits were provided to such children and lactating mothers.
- 3. Support to re-build houses:** GI sheets were provided to the 60 families in Dima Hasao district to rebuild their kuccha houses which got destroyed during the flood. The tribal people from this areas rely on items which are available in the jungle such as Bamboo, Tree leaves, strings from tree etc to build their houses except the roof where they use GI sheets.
- 4. Supporting the treatment and Food for livestock:** Veterinary camps were organised in partnership with the Veterinary department to conduct medical check-ups and to provide food for livestock 5 villages are catered during the camps. The diarrhea, foot and mouth disease, tetanus are commonly seen in animals in flood-affected areas. As livestock and its products are one of the major source of income for the people of this communities. Therefore lose of any livestock post flood will create double burden on the families.



# REHABILITATION AND POST FLOOD ACTIVITIES

**5. WASH Kits for Schools:** Wash kits were distributed in the schools where the flood water came inside the classrooms or schools are designated as relief camps in the districts of Morigaon, Nagaon and Kamrup. The items were provided to the schools based on the list shared by the office of Inspectors of schools.

**6. Dry Ration Distribution :** Dry ration were provided under food for work initiative where the member from each household will contribute their physical labour to repair the kuchha road inside the village, clean community halls etc. In addition to that, ration is provided to community kitchens where the people have to stay for the period of next 4-5 months or till the rainy season gets over.

## EXPERIENCES

### **Ananta Kumarnath**

Darrang District, choto Nagaon



"We have been staying in these roadside camps for around 17 to 18 days. Our houses and fields are submerged in 5 feet of water. The situation worsened after the nearby river over flooded. Economically, we have suffered a lot as our landfills which were our source to income have been damaged, and houses have broken down leaving us with no place to stay.

After the 1986 flood when we were kids, this year's flood 2022 is the massive one. However, we hadn't witnessed such a drastic one until this year. We have received a lot of help from people close by who haven't been affected by the floods and the NGOs- from milk to varieties of other goods, people tried to help as and how they could."

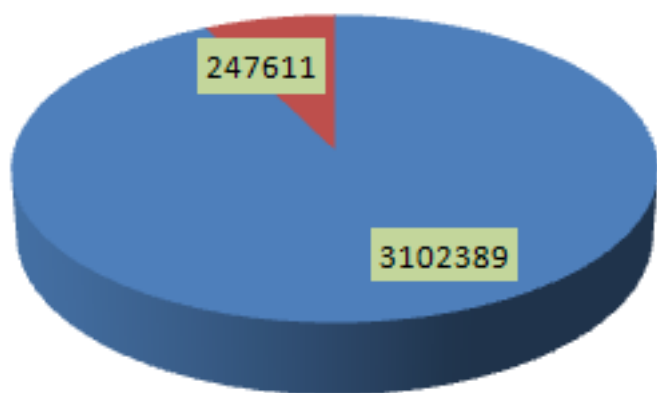

We have tried to diversify our influence and support and will surely continue to try doing so in other ventures in the future.



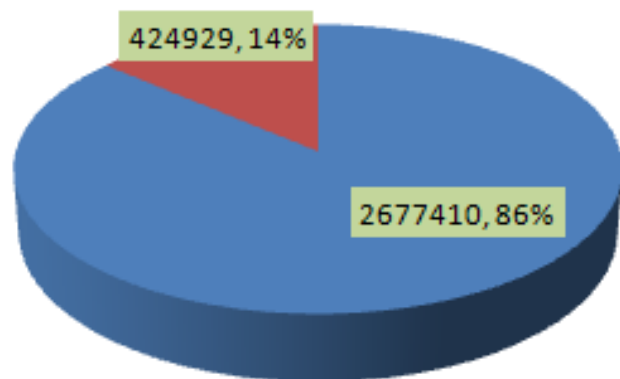

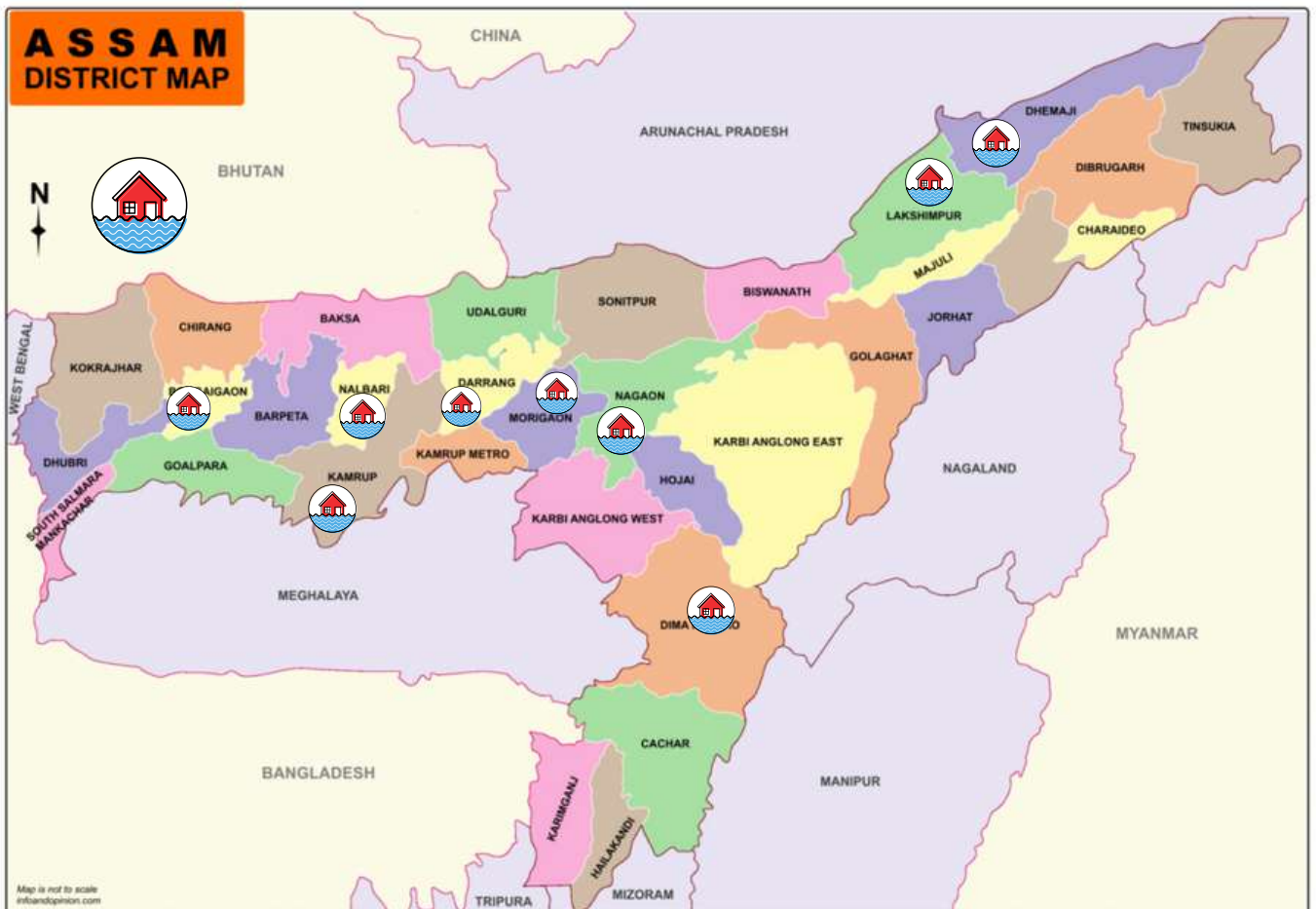
